

## How to Create a Simple Web View Application

1. Create a new Xcode project, use "Single View Application" template - no storyboard, but select to use reference counting
2. Click on ViewController.xib to show it in the middle window.
3. Drag a WebView from the Library and place it on the window. Size it to fit the entire window.
4. Click on the Tuxedo icon to open the editor window in the right pane next to the GUI View
5. Click on the WebView and press the Control key and drag the webview to the ViewController.h file. You will see a little blue line. Give it a name like, "webDisplay."
6. Switch to the ViewController.m file and past the following code in the "ViewDidLoad" method.

```
NSString *urlAddress = @"http://www.google.com";
NSURL *url = [NSURL URLWithString:urlAddress];
NSURLRequest *requestObj = [NSURLRequest requestWithURL:url];
[webDisplay loadRequest:requestObj];
[super viewDidLoad];
```

Change the URL string to whatever you want to load. Change "webDisplay" to whatever you called your webview when you dragged it to the .h file and gave it a name.

7. Compile and run!
